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Now Jordan Brand has created their nike shoes own interpretation of the design, replacing Nike logos with Jumpmans which will appropriately house the upcoming Air Jordan 12 Retros like the "Master" edition seen here, which will hit retail on February 27, 2016. Earlier today, Sneaker News showed you the Air Jordan 8.0 and Nike Zoom Hyperdunk 2011 Supreme from the Carrier Classic Pack – a set of sneakers that will be worn by the players of the UNC Tar Heels and Michigan State Spartans during Friday evening's season opener. Alongside the two sneakers is the Carrier Classic Collection by Jordan Brand and Nike Basketball; both team jerseys feature the digital camouflage detailing with special team-specific graphics on the rear side of the jersey.

Both jerseys are made with recycled polyester; for a point of reference, each full jersey uses thirty-six plastic bottles. The Carrier Classic jerseys are just a precursor to a lengthy plan set by Nike and Jordan Brand; in 2011, they expect to double its usage of recycled polyester, diverting more than 440 million plastic bottles from waste landfills. In addition to the Fall 2011 NCAA uniforms, the Spring 2012 Platinum Elite uniforms will continue usage of recycled materials, with its Elite short being made entirely of plastic bottles. The Jordan Flight Runner is headed to retailers tomorrow, May 1st. The shoe is the first running silhouette created by Jordan Brand as they continue to branch out from shoes featured on the hardwood to the likes of lifestyle and training. Featuring Dynamic Fit technology and Nike Zoom cushioning, this Dark Concord pair features subtle Jumpman branding in Infrared. And while NikeiD has changed up their Saturday release schedule, this pair will arrive at the online retailer tomorrow at the old 8:00 AM EST. Be sure to stick around after the click to get a better Nike 360 view of the first Jordan Flight Runner release and let us know if you plan on picking up a pair once they hit retailers tomorrow.

Bordeauxs, Cardinals, True Blues. These are just a few of the high profile nicknames that accompany soon-to-release Air Jordan Retros and the fact that sneakerheads have pet names for our favorite Jays is no secret to Jordan Brand. Check out the dope new Jordan Kick Names t-shirts, the latest in a growing line of garments celebrating sneakerheadism, this one offering the model's number and name in a massive list down the left side that crushes any of those Helvetica – 'n' looks. They're done in alphabetical order from the Altitudes to the True Blues with about twenty of the best in between, so click through to get a better look and grab the Jordan Kick Names tee in either black or white right now from NikeStore.

The sneaker combines the DNA of the Zoom Vapor Tour 9.5 with the iconic elements of the Air Jordan III, as seen by the elephant print on the toe and heel, the Jumpman tongue, and the Nike Air on the heel. The sneaker is still very much the Vapor Tour 9.5, with the Dynamic Fit and Zoom Air allowing this rebuilt sneaker to be fully wearable on the court. In fact, if you tune into Federer's first match Nike Air of the U.S. Open tonight, you'll see the shoes on his feet.

The Jordan Melo M10 "YOTH" will release on February 8th, 2014. While we still haven't seen Carmelo Anthony's entry into the range of 2014 All-Star Jordans, at the very least we've got a good look at this zodiac special. The sneaker goes the rare route of actually utilizing leather instead of the standard set of synthetics that we've grown used to with respect to modern basketball models.
